FISHER ROAD (WILSON ROAD TO HAGUE AVENUE) PROJECT



Project Description

This project will reduce Fisher Road, between Wilson Road and N. Hague Avenue, from four lanes to three lanes. The project will also add bike lanes and construct sidewalks on both sides of the road.

Project Purpose

Improve safety and provide mobility options for pedestrians and cyclists.

Impacts

Environmental

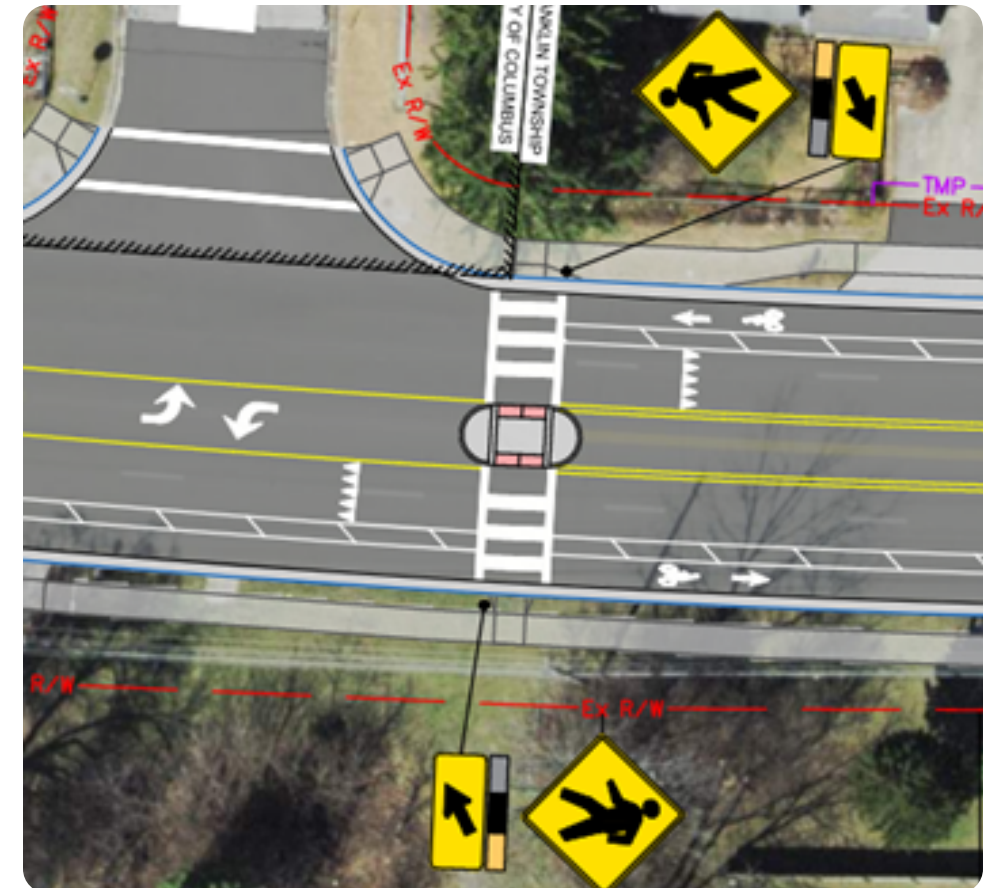
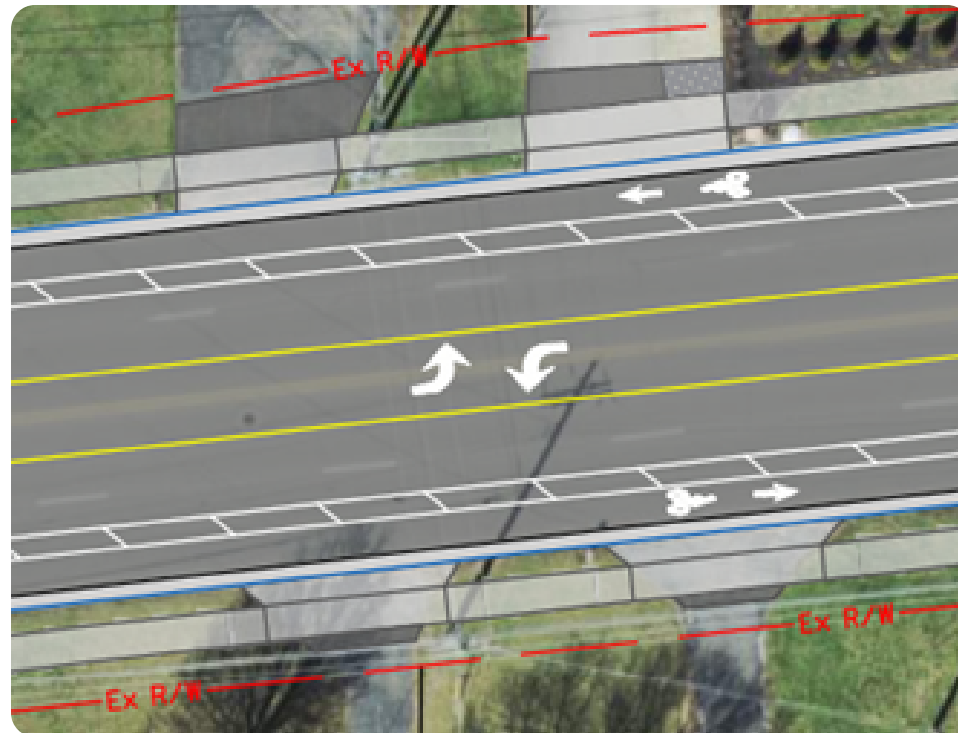
- Project falls within Zone A per FEMA Flood Mapping.
- Some trees will need to be removed.

Utilities

- Aerial and underground utility relocations needed.
- Relocations work beginning Fall 2026.

Right-Of-Way

- Temporary and permanent right-of-way will be needed.
- Driveways will need replaced to tie into the new sidewalk
- A real estate representative will contact you directly as design proceeds to discuss the right-of-way needs, acquisition process and your rights under that process.



Proposed Improvement Summary

- Reduce Fisher Road to one thru lane and a two-way left turn lane from Wilson Road to Hague Avenue.
- Construct pedestrian facilities on both sides of Fisher Rd along with on-street buffered bike lanes.
- Install pedestrian crossings with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) at Maclam Drive and Nixon Drive.
- Replace driveway aprons to facilitate sidewalk construction.

Maintenance of Traffic:

- Fisher Road will remain open to traffic during construction.
- Flaggers will be used to control traffic around work zones.
